
We also offer resources for the public, from a Google map to help find Canadian farm sanctuaries in your area, to best practice information on how to start a farm sanctuary.

P.E.A.C.E. Rescue started in 2019 with the mission to help farm sanctuaries and farmed animals, as we saw a need for an organization dedicated to helping with rescue, transport, and medical costs of farmed animals.

THE BILLY FUND

The Billy Fund was created in memory of a very special individual who was rescued early 2019 by P.E.A.C.E. They had a larger than life personality but sadly the cards were stacked against them with being born with wry neck and other disabilities. Though they had a short life, they've made an everlasting impact, and in honour of their memory, The Billy Fund was created to help other rescues like themselves who have disabilities.

The Billy Fund supports animals with unique medical needs, or disabilities. Funded items include mobility devices, medical bills and therapeutic procedures.

2023 ACCOMPLISHMENTS



- Through grant and MacQueen Systems support, we built two wheelchair-accessible compost toilets on site, creating an inclusive and environmentally friendly bathroom setup for our volunteers, events and tours.
- **P.E.A.C.E. Farm Sanctuary:**
 - We became the first microsanctuary in the world, and second farm sanctuary in Canada to get accredited by the Global Federation of Animal Sanctuaries (GFAS).
 - Through grant support and fundraising, we were able to build an addition to the rooster space, specifically for ducks.
 - Through grant support and fundraising, we started the animal-centred design farm sanctuary expansion to offer a home to more rescues in 2024 with our current pig and goat sanctuary residents.
- We received our Veganic Farm Certification through NAVCS, in partnership with Slabbert Family Veganic Farm.



- **P.E.A.C.E. Humane:**
 - Through grant support, we were able to work with teacher Catherine Lamarche and create lesson plans for Canadian farm sanctuary operators and teachers, to help bring young people to sanctuary.
- **P.E.A.C.E. Rescue:**
 - We helped 19 rescues find homes at farm sanctuaries.
- **The Billy Fund:**
 - We were able to help Rosie from Lily's Place Animal Sanctuary in New Brunswick, Canada.
- With support from Liberation BC, we did a screening of the documentary The Last Pig at UBC Robson Square in Vancouver, BC.
- Seven Canadian vegan farm sanctuaries renewed their vegan sanctuary & compassion for all pledge.
- Our co-founder and executive director, Sarien Slabbert, did two public presentations for:
 - The Animal Save Movement - Rescue Group.
 - Planted Expo Vancouver, BC.





2023 FINANCIAL OVERVIEW




EXPENSES*
